By entering into a joint tenancy, you should understand that both joint tenants have equal rights. If the relationship breaks down in the future, your rights to the tenancy may be at risk. For example, if one joint tenant gives us a notice to quit, the tenancy will end for all tenants and you will lose any rights under the tenancy.

We would strongly suggest that you get some independent advice from Citizens Advice, an advice centre or a solicitor before you proceed with this application.
